The Harvest Hub is a secure, centralized, cold storage facility in downtown Squamish. It is a shared distribution resource designed to support local food businesses and strengthen the regional food economy.

OPTION 1

HARVEST HUB STORAGE

- Rent short-term storage space (freezer, cooler, pantry) to independently fulfill orders for customer pickups.
- Ideal for:
 - CSA share pickups
 - Businesses with an existing online or phone ordering system
 - Businesses that want the flexibility to schedule pickups on their own timeline
 - Wholesale/ high volume order fulfillment
- Customers place orders directly with your business and pick them up at the Harvest Hub
- Rates: \$15–\$25 per day.

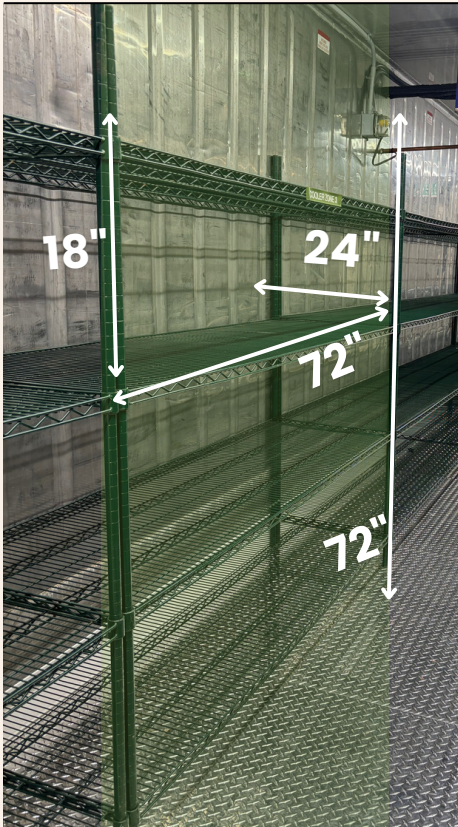
OPTION 2

HARVEST HUB ONLINE MARKETPLACE

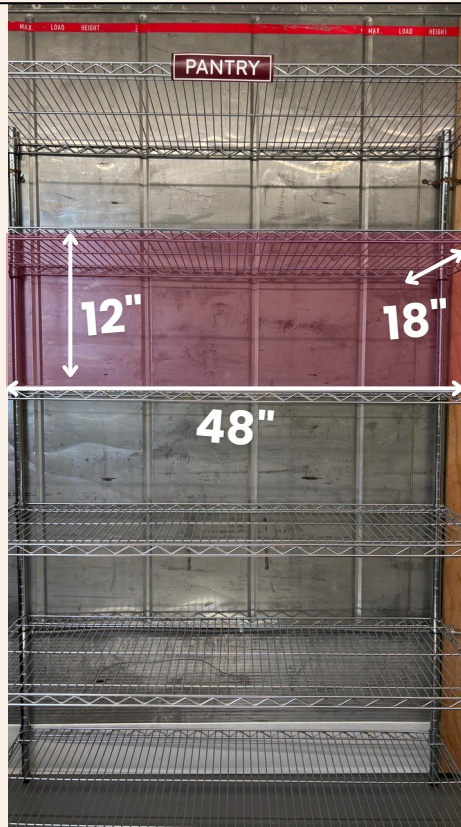
- Facilitate sales through our online marketplace (Homegrown.food), customer pick up at the Hub.
- One day of pick ups so customers can order from multiple producers in one trip (TBD day of week)
- Only pay when you make sales.
- Gives customers the opportunity to buy from many producers via one online platform and pick up location.
- Support from Harvest Hub staff to organize orders.
- Cost structure: 10% marketplace fee + Square processing fee

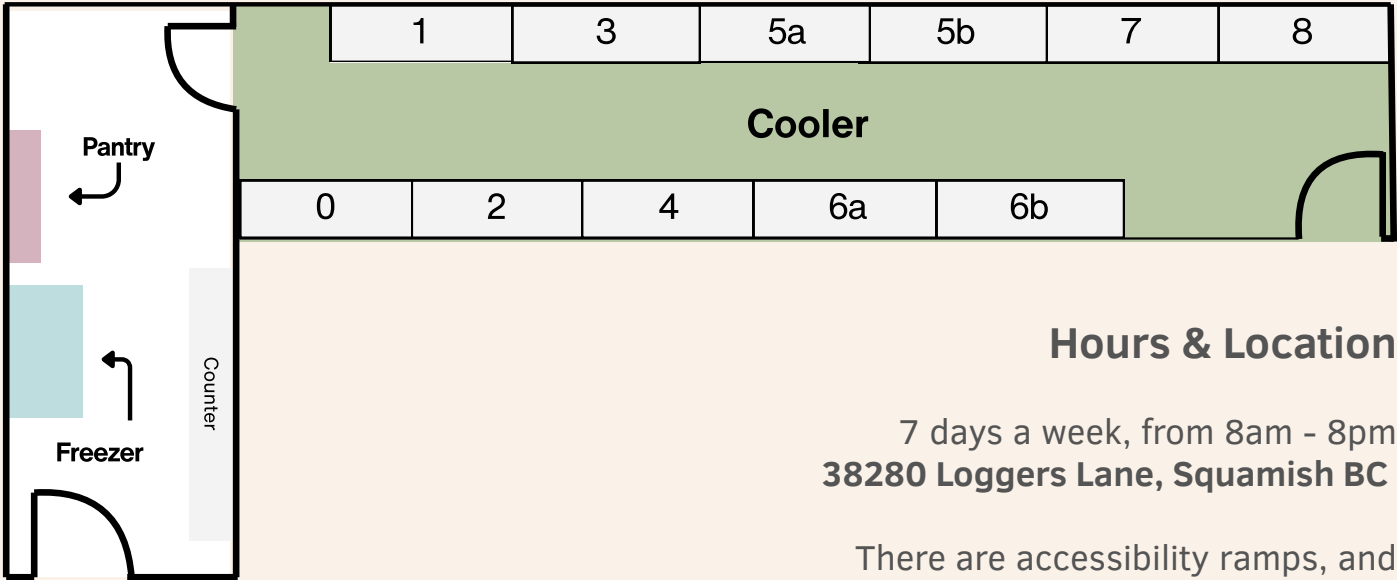
COOLER (4 °C)

How Will the Harvest Hub Ensure Security?

- Restricted access via digital keypad entry and four surveillance cameras for secure, traceable use.
- Insulated construction for year-round temperature stability.
- Built-in cooling and temperature monitoring with automated data tracking.
- While the facility operates without full-time staff, a team member visits multiple times per week to maintain the space, ensure cleanliness, and manage any missed orders.
